

Lenten Spiritual and Prayer Practice?

We will be reading Richard Foster's book
Prayer

Finding the Heart's True Home

a book which examines different kinds of Prayer
as Journeys Inward, Upward and Outward.

Those interested would need to buy the book, it's available on Amazon. The book has 21 chapters of 10-12 pages and each chapter speaks to a different prayer/prayer practice. In preparation for each week we would read four chapters of the book (a chapter and a bit every other day of the week if you want to break it down!). At our gatherings we would discuss prayer and particularly the prayers that we have been reading about, heading home with one prayer practice for the week.

We would meet for one hour (or more if we like talking with each other!) each week from the 2nd week of March through the 2nd week of April. The specific day would be chosen by the group, trying to accommodate all those who are interested in participating.
