

COVID Information Zoom Presentation.

Given the anxiety over COVID, how it is passed and caught, we might be very unsure as to what we can and cannot do during these times. Public Health has given us guidelines and we need to be following their recommendations. While we know what we shouldn't be doing, we are not always clear as to why. And, subsequently, we are not always sure what we can do. So, we've asked a couple of our medical people at Grace, Carmel Wiebe and Curtis Krahn, to join us for a Zoom gathering to inform us more thoroughly in regards to this. They'll share among other things, an overview how viruses work and how they don't, the rationale behind why masks, and physical distancing work. We will provide an opportunity for questions after their brief presentations. So, join us on **Wed, November 11th, 7:00. Grace Zoom Formation, Racism and the Church, November 10 at 7:30 pm. Other than the current pandemic, racial conflict has probably been the second leading human heartbreak of 2020. While eruptions of racial violence have been most acute in America, we Canadians have our own long history of practicing some of the most egregious forms of racism. Shamefully, white Christian settler denominations have been equally guilty of oppressing BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Colour). How well do we understand the enduring subtleties and depths of racism, even in our own churches? How can we play a positive part in what now appears to be a profound societal reckoning with racism? This four-part Formation series will take place online via Zoom meetings on the following Tuesday evenings. **On November 10, Steve Heinrichs from Mennonite Church Canada will join us to offer his denominational insights.** All sessions will be hosted by Monica Martens.
