Darryl Klassen, author of *The Anabaptist-Evangelical Puzzle* (2019), has 28 years of pastoral experience in two Evangelical Mennonite churches. He currently serves as adjunct professor of Anabaptist History at Steinbach Bible College, and his book examines the relationship of Anabaptism to modern evangelicalism. Beyond defining the two movements, intersecting topics such as eschatology, biblical interpretation, and political involvement will be discussed.

Grace Tree Planting Project
