Our Coins Count money will be going to MCC's Grow Hope Campaign, where \$350 "sponsors" one acre of farmland here in Manitoba. After harvest, the Grow Hope farmer will sell the crop and donate the proceeds to MCC's account at the Canadian Foodgrains Bank, which is matched 4:1 by the Canadian government. That means that every dollar we give can become up to 5 dollars to provide emergency food aid. Anabaptist Bible Project: Anabaptism began 500 years ago when bold young Christians challenged authorities with the radical idea that Scripture spoke clearly to ordinary people who studied the Bible together. To celebrate the 500th anniversary of Anabaptism a project is planned to create an Anabaptism Bible. It will be a "people's Bible" that, if recruiting is successful, will draw on the work of 500 small groups of laypeople who will write marginal notes and commentary. 500 study groups will get a "3-4-5" assignment: read three passages of Scripture (the entire Bible will be divided into 500 sets of three passages and assignments given), meet four times and respond to five discussion questions.
