Renovation Loan Pledge Drive

As agreed, at the January 29th AGM, a pledge drive to raise funds towards paying down the renovation loan at the SCU will be held this May. By raising \$ 300,000 of the remaining \$ 465,000 balance, we are seeking to reduce the interest cost exposure significantly and in a way that gives us all a chance to participate in a manner suitable to everyone's budget.




The table is full of great reads. Here are a few selections.
